Requirement CHECKLIST- Place a check next to each number as you complete it

 $_$ 1. Use one inch margins all around the text of the paper ["File" \Rightarrow "Page Setup"]. Use Times New Roman
12 point font and double space.
 _ 2. Do not use the back of the paper.
 _ 3. Organize your paper in this order: paper, works cited page, rubric, outline (showing).
 _ 4. On every page, including the works cited page, put your last name and page number (without a
comma) in the top right hand corner. Use the "Header" option in Word ["View" \rightarrow "Header/Footer"].
 _ 5. Check for correct grammar, mechanics, and spelling.
 _ 6. Use the correct format for citing sources and the for the works cited page.
 _ 7. Remember to document ALL ideas that are not your own.
 _ 8. Staple the paper in the left corner. Do not use report covers or a cover page.
 9. Make sure your paper starts with a hook and finishes with a thought provoking final thought.
 $_$ 10. Make sure your thesis statement is the last sentence in the introduction.
 $_$ 11. The \P 's should go in the order listed in the thesis statement.
 _ 12. You should have at least one paragraph for each prong of your thesis statement.
 _ 13. Each paragraph should have a topic and a concluding sentence that are YOUR OWN (they should
generally not be cited).
 _ 14. Your paper should be coherent and should flow logically. Transition words and sentences should be
used throughout.
 _ 15. Your conclusion should summarize your paper.
 _ 16. Remember to keep your opinions out of the paper.
 _ 17. Do not use first person (I, me, we) or second person (you) in the paper. Also, keep the paper
formal. Do not use contractions.
 _ 18. YOU MUST HAVE AT LEAST 3 <u>BOOK</u> SOURCES CITED IN YOUR PAPER AND ON YOUR WORKS CITED
PAGE. YOU CAN HAVE AS MANY OTHER SOURCES AS YOU NEED.
 _ 19. Remember to reference the rubric as you write your paper.
 _ 20. Remember to give your paper a <i>creative</i> title in regular Times New Roman 12 pt. font (no word art,
not bolded or underlined).
 _ 21. Your paper should be 3-5 paged doubled spaced (not including the works cited page).
 _ 22. Proper spacing should be consistent throughout paper—no extra spaces between paragraphs (check
spacing "Before" & "After") or after the title or heading.
23. You will need 25 note cards turned in with your first and last name & English period in a rubber band.
