- 1.) <u>**R**</u>ead the passage.
- 2.) Cover it up and try to <u>Remember what it says</u>. Then, in your own words, summarize the main ideas in the passage and write it down.
- 3.) *S*can over the passage again and see if there is anything important that you missed.
- 4.) <u>T</u>ouch up your summary with any pertinent information you missed.
