Bibliographies 101:

1. A bibliography should be its own page.
2. Make sure the entries appear in alphabetical order by first word.
3. Do NOT number the entries.
4. Always double space.
5. Each entry should be a hanging indent.
6. The page should be titled Bibliography.
7. All dates should be written MLA style.
8. When citing a URL, split between lines ONLY at a slash.



Books: Author last name, first name. Title of book. City of publication: Publisher, Year published.

Ex: Ehrenrich, Barbara. Dancing in the Streets: A History of Collective Joy. New York, New York: Metropolitan-Holt, 2006.

Bibliographies (cont.): Websites

Websites: Author or editor last name, first name (if any). Title of website. Organization who sponsors the site, date of most recent publication or update. Web. Date you accessed the site. <url>.
